Based on this, I wrote the text from the point of view of someone walking through northern woods at night (specifically mentioning pine trees) and also referencing stars (and indirectly, Polaris, aka "The North Star"), which have been used for thousands of years by many different civilizations to navigate their path. As for the music, I wrote most of the piece using the Lydian and Dorian modes, as I found those to be majestic and ethereal, evoking a sense of wonder and beauty.
